Stage 1: Selection	
Online application The online application is your first chance to express what motivates you for pursuing a career in the National Intelligence Community. Please note that you'll need to upload your resume, academic transcripts, and proof of Australian citizenship.	Open on Monday 4 March 2024 and close on Monday 29 April at 11:30PM (AEST)
Online Testing* This stage may include a work preferences and cognitive test, a one-way interview, or other selection activities.	May/June 2024
Panel interview Conducted via video conference with two or three members of the selection panel (Approximately 30 minutes).	June/July 2024
Referee checks Referee checks may be carried out during the interview stage with your nominated referees.	July 2024
Merit Pool and Matching The merit pool will remain active until September 2025. Please note that not everyone in the merit pool will be matched with an agency and progress to Stage 2: Suitability.	August 2024
Stage 2: Suitability	
Agency security assessment Candidates at this stage are required to undertake their agency's thorough security clearance process to obtain a Top Secret Positive Vetting / Privileged Access security clearance	May take up to 18-24 months to complete
